2021 Above and Beyond Student Award goes to seaweed packaging idea



Students from the University of Northampton pitched innovative ideas to address Blue Skies challenges at this year's Blue Skies 'Above and Beyond Student Award' in association with the FBL Challenge. Under graduates, post-graduates and MBA students from across the Faculty of Business and Law presented their creative solutions to tackle Blue Skies sustainability priorities around plastic, waste and emissions.

In the hotly contested business competition, students presented a host of potential developments for Blue Skies, including using fruit byproducts to serve the emerging market of plant-based feminine hygiene products, a plastic-free fruit dispensing system for supermarkets and diversifying the Blue Skies product range to include fruit-based fabrics.

A panel of judges, which included Hella, Jayne, Lana and Denzil from Blue Skies, and the Dean of the Faculty, Karen Jones, and Director of the Centre for Sustainable Business Practices, Amin Hosseinian-Far, assessed the student presentations based on Blue Skies innovations criteria.

The winning idea, pitched by Law students Kyle Willis and Drishtee Bhowaneesing, with their plan to introduce a plastic alternative into the Blue Skies packaging, by the cultivation of seaweed, which can be transformed into a plastic-like wrap.
